## **SDSTA Fall Meeting**

Monday, July 31, 2006 Rapid City, SD

The meeting was called to order at 12:50 by President Micheline Hickenbotham. Members present were President Micheline, Mark and Marcy Farrand, James Stearns and Molly TenBroek.
